INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLECTING A FOOTING SAMPLE

Proper interpretations of footing sample analysis results are highly dependent upon collecting a representative sample. Each footing sample should be a composite of subsamples collected from a number of areas within the arena. It is very important when taking the samples, to scoop the footing down through the depth to directly above the base.

Collect the subsamples in a clean bucket, mix thoroughly, and fill a **gallon** large zip lock bag $\frac{3}{4}$ full.
